Marrington Outdoor Recreation Area Multi-use Trail System

The Marrington multi-use trail system has been constructed by and for off-road cyclists, runners and hikers under the auspices of JB Charleston's Natural Resources office.

PLEASE OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:

Users must carry a Department of Defense ID or DBIS badge and Marrington Patron Pass.

Users under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a sponsor 21 years of age or older.

Cyclists must wear helmets and carry sound-producing device; protective gear such as glasses and gloves recommended.

Protect the trail - Wet Trail Policy: do not ride any trail for 24 hours after a rain and stay on the trail.

Off road driving and/or trail use by motorized vehicles is prohibited. Recreational use of ATVs on base is not authorized.

Equestrians and hikers have the right of way. Cyclists must make their presence known before passing other users.

Cyclists meeting equestrians should get off and stand with their bikes between them and the horses while the horses pass.

For emergencies call 911. To report trail use issues or maintenance problems call 794-795.

During deer season (Aug 15 to Jan 01) patrons may not use the trail system during the following time periods:

Mon, Wed and Fri - 1600 to sunset (Daylight Savings Time) and 1500 to sunset (Eastern Standard Time)

Night riding is allowed on hunting days 30 minutes after Official Sunset.

Saturday, Sunday and federal holidays - 0400 to 0900

During small game season Jan 02 to March 01 - Saturday, Sunday and federal holidays: 0400 to 0900
